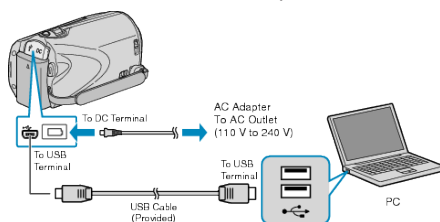


Copying to Mac Computer

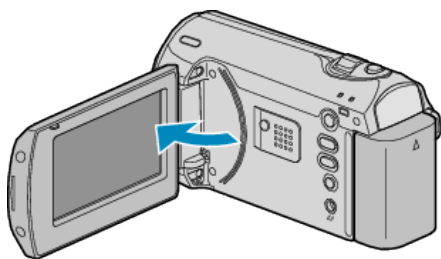
Copy the files to a Mac computer using the following method.

1 Connect the USB cable and the AC adapter.



- ① Connect the AC adapter to this unit.
 - ② Connect using the provided USB cable.
- The provided software is not required for this process.

2 Open the LCD monitor.



- The USB MENU appears.

3 Select "PLAYBACK ON PC" and press OK.



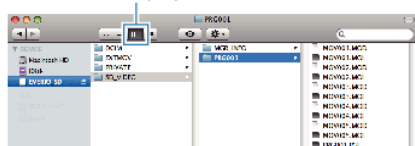
- The subsequent operations are to be performed on the PC.

4 Click on the "EVERIO_SD" icon on the desktop.

- The folder opens.

5 Click on the column display icon.

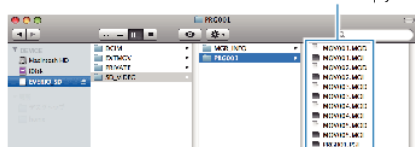
Column Display Icon



- Search the folder with the desired files.

6 Copy the files to any folder in the PC (desktop, etc).

Files to Copy



CAUTION:

- When the folders or files are deleted/moved/renamed in the computer, they cannot be played back on this unit anymore.
 - MOD files that are copied to a Mac computer cannot be imported to iMovie.
- To use MOD files with iMovie, import the files using iMovie.

Memo:

- To edit the files, use a software that supports MOD files.
- When removing this unit from the PC, drag&drop the "EVERIO_SD" icon on the desktop to the trash bin.

iMovie

You can import files from this unit to a PC using Apple's iMovie'08 or '09. To verify the system requirements, select "About This Mac" from the Apple menu. You can determine the operating system version, processor and amount of memory.
