## **Manual Recording**

You can adjust settings, such as brightness and shutter speed, by using the manual mode.

Manual recording can be set for both video and still image modes.


1 Select video or still image mode.



- The video or still image mode icon appears.
- 2~ Select the Manual recording mode.



- The mode changes between Auto and Manual with every touch.
- 3 Start recording.



• Press again to stop.

Name	Description
SCENE SE- LECT	<ul> <li>Recordings that suit the shooting conditions can be performed easily.</li> <li>"Scene Selection" (ISP P. 0)</li> </ul>
FOCUS	<ul> <li>Use manual focus if the subject is not focused automatically.</li> <li>"Adjusting Focus Manually" (I P. 0 )</li> </ul>
BRIGHT- NESS AD- JUST	<ul> <li>Overall brightness on the screen can be adjusted.</li> <li>Use this when recording in a dark or bright location.</li> <li>"Adjusting Brightness" (ISP.0)</li> </ul>
SHUTTER SPEED	<ul> <li>Shutter speed can be adjusted.</li> <li>Use this when shooting a fast-moving subject or to emphasize the subject's movement.</li> <li>"Setting Shutter Speed" (INP P. 0)</li> </ul>
WHITE BAL- ANCE	<ul> <li>Overall color on the screen can be adjusted.</li> <li>Use this when the color on the screen appears differently from the actual color.</li> <li>"Setting White Balance" (FR P. 0)</li> </ul>
BACKLIGHT COMP.	<ul> <li>Corrects the image when the subject appears dark due to backlight.</li> <li>Use this when shooting against the light.</li> <li>"Setting Backlight Compensation" (ISP.0)</li> </ul>
METERING AREA/ TYPE	<ul> <li>Brightness of a specified area can be set as the standard.</li> <li>"Setting Metering Area" (</li></ul>
EFFECT	<ul> <li>Images that look like old photographs or black-and- white movies can be taken.</li> <li>"Recording with Effects (GZ-MS250/GZ-MS240/GZ- MS230)" (For P. 0)</li> </ul>
TELE MAC- RO	Use this to take close-up (macro) shots of the sub- ject.     "Taking Close-up Shots" (☞ P. 0 )
