
Capturing Videos for Uploading to YouTube

Capture and copy a part of a recorded video (maximum 15 minutes) for uploading to YouTube, and save it as a YouTube video.

When capturing videos for YouTube, the duration cannot be longer than 15 minutes.

1 Select video mode.




2 Tap ▶ to select the playback mode.



3 Tap "MENU".



4 Tap "UPLOAD SETTINGS".



5 Tap the video to edit.



- 6 Tap "TRIM".
 - When trimming is not necessary, tap "DO NOT TRIM".




• If the selected video is more than 15 minutes, trimming is necessary.

7 Tap II to pause playback at the desired start point, then tap "A".



8 Tap ■ to pause playback at the desired end point, then tap "B".



- To reset the start or end point, tap "A" or "B" at the desired scene (position).
- When capturing videos for YouTube, the duration cannot be longer than 15 minutes.
- 9 Tap "SET".



10 Tap "YES".



- After copying, tap "OK".
- When copying finishes, the copied file is added to the index screen.
- To exit upload settings, tap "STOP" on the upload settings screen.

Memo:

• The division point may deviate slightly from the selected scene.

Uploading Videos to YouTube

You can upload your videos to YouTube using the provided software Everio MediaBrowser 3. Install the software on your PC and connect this unit to the PC.
