
Dubbing Files to a VHS Tape by Connecting to a VCR

You can dub videos in standard quality by connecting to a VCR.

- Refer also to the instruction manuals of the TV and VCR.
- Connect to a VCR/DVD recorder.



- * The AC adapter shown in the illustration is AC-V10M.
- 1 Connect using the provided AV cable.
- 2 Connect the AC adapter to this unit.
- This unit powers on automatically when the AC adapter is connected.
- Be sure to use the supplied JVC AC adapter.
- 2 Tap to select the playback mode.



- 3 Prepare the TV/VCR for recording.
 - Switch to a compatible external input.
 - Insert a video tape.
- 4 Prepare this unit for playback.
 - Set "VIDEO OUTPUT" in the "COMMON" menu to the aspect ratio ("4:3" or "16:9") of the connecting TV.
- 5 Start recording.
 - Start playback on this unit and press the record button on the recorder.
 - After playback is complete, stop the recording.
