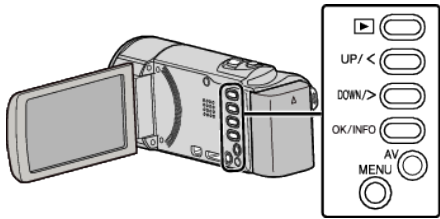


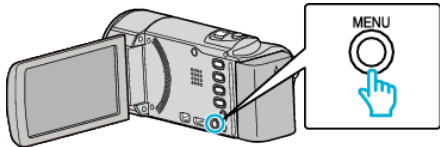
Setting White Balance

You can set the color tone to suit the light source.

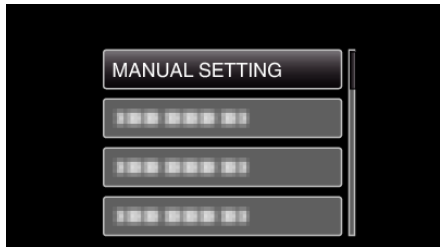
Memo : To select/move cursor towards up/left or down/right, press the button UP/< or DOWN/>.



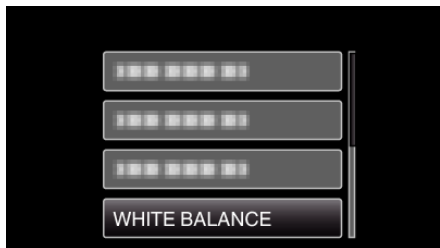
1 Press MENU.



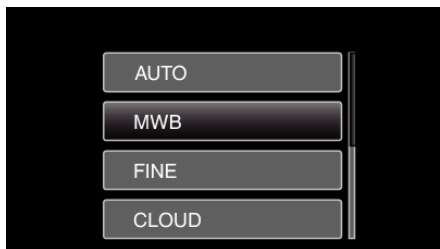
2 Select “MANUAL SETTING” and press OK.



3 Select “WHITE BALANCE” and press OK.



4 Select the white balance setting and press OK.



Setting	Details
AUTO	Adjusts automatically to the natural colors.
MWB	Use this when the problem of unnatural colors is not resolved.
FINE	Set this when shooting outdoors on a sunny day.
CLOUD	Set this when shooting on a cloudy day or inside a shade.
HALOGEN	Set this when shooting under illumination such as a video light.

- 2 Select “MWB” and keep pressing OK.
 - The cursor blinks.
- 3 Release OK after the menu disappears.

Using MWB

1 Hold a sheet of plain white paper in front of the lens so that the white paper fills the screen.
